This interactive four-day programme is for Registered Nurses and Allied Healthcare Professionals (AHPs) working in community or inpatient settings across the Trust and addresses the key principles in Adult Palliative Care. It aims to equip staff with core knowledge and skills in delivering palliative and end of life care including:

- Advance Care Planning
- Assessment and Care Planning
- Care in the Dying Phase
- Syringe Driver Management
- Symptom Management
- Sage and Thyme™ training (foundation level workshop learning how to use evidence-based skills when listening and responding)
- Understanding Spiritual Care
- Palliative Care Emergencies
- Introduction to Loss and Grief
- Wellbeing/Caring for Each Other

This is a competency-based programme with **sessions delivered in person and online through Zoom.** Staff will need to attend all sessions. Competency booklets will be issued at the beginning of the programme for completion in clinical practice. Each person attending will need to identify a mentor in their team to support achievement of the competencies.
